Omowale provides organizational development, training and consultation services to over 50 social justice, health/human service, community development and philanthropic organizations across the country annually. He has served on the boards of local, regional, and national organizations including the Applied Research Center (ARC) and Urban Habitat in Oakland, CA; CDI, Teen Home and Girls Club of the Mid-peninsula in East Palo Alto, CA; and the Praxis Project, in Washington, D.C.

Omowale is the immediate past President of the Alliance for Nonprofit Management Board, in Washington, D.C. Omowale has also served on the East Palo Alto City Council and the San Mateo County Planning Commission.
